Jumping On Guests Quick Tips

It can be embarrassing or even rude for our dogs to jump up and knock over or scratch our guests, even if they're dog people. If you'd like to improve your dog's greeting manners and help your guests have a more pleasant expeirence when coming over, take a look at a few quick tips!

How to help reduce jumping up on guests

- 1. Stop the cycle- You can put your dog on leash or behind a gate at first until they're a bit calmer
- 2. Prepare- have your guests tell you before they arrive so you can prepare yourself and your dog
- 3. Reward calm behavior- have your guests give attention and pets when your dog is not jumping, or when they're sitting
 - a. Give your dog some exercise (brain and body) before your guests arrive.
- 4. Play before- engage your dog in a game of fetch, tug or hide and seek, or a walk before your guests arrive to take the edge off
- 5. Practice- practice with your greetings with your dog when you come home for example. Set the new routine to show your dog what behaviors and manners you prefer.

All dogs can learn calmer greeting manners and get lots of attention from you and your guests without jumping up!
